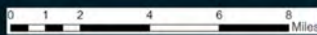

MAP DESCRIPTION

The Hazardous Sites map considers proximity to superfunds, brownfields, and Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Information (RCRAInfo) sites. These sites are considered hazardous due to different kinds of contamination. Studies by Mascarenhas et al (2021) and Lodge et al (2020) found residents may experience more impacts living within 1.8 miles from a superfund and 0.12 miles from brownfield or RCRAInfo site. Areas closer to a hazardous site were given lower suitability scores than areas farther from the sites.
